The illegal Occupation Wall that has been built through the Jerusalem suburb of Abu Dis and cuts it off from the city centre, stops people from reaching their hospitals, leisure facilities and the job market they rely on, and has divided hundreds of families. Unfortunately this is only one of the human rights problems that people in Abu Dis suffer from under the Israeli occupation.

Projects so far include:

- Support for a community centre, youth club and women's group in Abu Dis
- Providing the internet for schools and linking teachers and students in Camden and Abu Dis
- Sending money for medicines and helping the Camden Clinic, Abu Dis
- Finding volunteer teachers of English and other subjects
- Support for an annual summer scheme for children
- Visits of children and adults from Abu Dis to Camden and also visits to Palestine so people can find out about the situation for themselves.
