WOMEN'S VISIT FROM PALESTINE

The Palestinian women visitors have gone after a very busy time here. There were 14 visitors of very varied backgrounds. They took part in a number of memorable things in Camden - a skills-sharing day, the Stories from our Mothers workshop, a public meeting on Jerusalem, visits to universities, nurseries, community centres, trade unions etc etc. They helped develop new links with Palestine and strengthen existing ones – between them, they then travelled to about 30 boroughs and towns across England, Scotland and Wales and spoke to thousands of people about human rights in Palestine. The Camden Abu Dis Women's Links group did the organising and supported the whole thing, and should be really proud of the achievement. Thanks to all of you who helped to make this big and complicated visit so successful.
